2022 ACCORD TONIQUE RED

Jazz Composition (Franck Tortiller & Quatuor Debussy)

Varietals in resonance

Grenache (50%), Carignan (20%), Syrah (10%), Cinsault (10%), Bourboulenc (10%) Cello, 2nd Violon, Alto, 1st Violon, Vibraphone

Organic Terroir

Red clay soils, with silicate pebbles, on terrasses overlooking the Rhone River.

Natural vinification

For 31 days and nights, the grapes have been lulled by the music composed by Franck Tortiller and interpreted by the Quatuor Debussy and Franck. The grapes have been hand harvested and fermented naturally without preservatives. Then partially aged in barrels with music around 6 months and finally, bottled without sulfite.

Tasting notes

Deep purple robe with violet reflects.

Very intense nose, aromatic, fruity, elegant and fresh.

Hints of black berries, undergrowth, licorice, grappa and Provencal spices. Round and dense mouth, with nice tannins.

Retro-olfaction on ripe red fruits.

THE WINEMAKER'S COMPOSITIONS

ACCURD TUNIQUE

The 2022 ACCORD TONIQUE reserve is an original creation, both musical and oenological, signed by Raphaël Pommier, organic winemaker, and by Jazz Composer Franck Tortiller & Quatuor Debussy

The winemaker identified the link between his varietals and the vibrations of the voice and of each instrument, creating a blend reflecting the musical harmony of the artists. An album has been then played 24h/24 during the natural fermentation, using loud-speakers installed inside in the vinification tank.

The vibration of the musical notes permanently stimulates the fermenting yeast. They produce under this stimulation way more aromatic complexity and new synergies between them.

The wine is full of savory tonic chords!
